D. Additional requirements

TR SAMSUN01

Ondokuz Mayis University (TR SAMSUN01) does not have a selection criterion for incoming students and staff. We rely on each partner university selecting their student/staff according to their national Erasmus selection criteria. All staff and students will be accepted in accordance to the Erasmus Inter-Institutional Agreement with only some exceptions:

For incoming placement students:

-depending on the availability of the relevant department and the suitability of the dates.

For incoming teaching and training staff:

-depending on the availability of the relevant department and the suitability of the dates.

OMU has the infrastructure to welcome students and staff with disabilities but certain arrangements can only be made with information prior to the mobility.

Partner institutions should send their nominations by email (pls. give student's first and family name, email, area of studies and semester of Erasmus scholarship).

The online application should be submitted by the students by the 1st of June or 1st of November.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.

Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

According to letter grades

a) G: pass grade for non-credit courses

b) M : grade for the courses considered "exempted"; e.g. the previously taken and recognized courses of the transferred students.

c) MZ: Grade incomplete for the students who did not attend any of the exams with an excuse, after completion of the make up exams, changed with the final grade

d) DC, DD, FF fail

e) FD: No Attendance

f) FG: Not attended to exams /fail

g) E: Grade incomplete for the practical courses,

G, E and M grades are not counted for GPA and CGPA calculations.

PL TORUN01:

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark

and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain zal. or zaliczenie (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
