D. Additional requirements

TR ISTANBU 03:

The selection criteria for students and staff are regulated by the sending university; measures for preparing, receiving and integrating mobile students and/or staff are organised by the receiving institution.

Erasmus Incoming Students have to choose courses from the department with which the agreement is existing, they can choose two courses from any faculties as long as the courses are not overlapping! For the implementation of STA/STT-mobilities, a letter of invitation – issued by a Istanbul University contact person – is required.

TR ISTANBU 03:

Decision Response: As receiving institution the University of Istanbul (TR ISTANBU03) will send its decision within 8 weeks.

Transcripts of Records: A Transcript of Records will be issued by University of Istanbul (TR ISTANBU03) no later than five weeks after the assessment period has finished.

Termination of Agreement: A unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 November 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

PL TORUNO1:

Partner institutions should send their nominations by email (pls. give student's first and family name, email, area of studies and semester of Erasmus scholarship).

The online application should be submitted by the students by the 1st of June or 1st of November.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.

Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

F. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

TRISTANBU 03:

ECTS Credits: Istanbul University uses the *European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System* (ECTS) which is a workload-based system for measuring and comparing study results. The student is awarded a certain number of ECTS credits for each course which reflects the workload necessary to successfully complete a course.

Credits are awarded only when the student has fulfilled the course requirements, for example regular attendance. The credits are allocated by the individual departments in accordance with the standard workload determined by the respective study and examination regulations whereby one credit equals 30 hours of study.

Please note that the Student Exchange Office refrains from prescribing a standard workload per semester.

PL TORUN01:

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain *zal.* or *zaliczenie* (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
