2. PL TORUNO1:

Partner institutions should send their nominations by email (pls. give student's first and family name, e-mail, area of studies and semester of Erasmus scholarship).

Students should apply according to the procedure given on http://www.umk.pl/en/cooperation/erasmus/students/application

The online application should be submitted by the students by the 1st of June or 1st of November.

3. The receiving institution will send its decision within 5 weeks.

SR ROVANIE01: SoleMOVE mobility system is used for exchange admissions and no paper applications are needed. The admission decision will be made by the faculties by June 16th (autumn semester and full year admission) / November 16th (spring semester admission) and the students will be informed directly by email through SoleMOVE -system.

- 4. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- SF ROVANIE01: Each student can print an unofficial Transcript of Records personally in the WebOODI system. The official Transcript of Records will be sent by the Faculty by the 1st of February (Autumn Semester) and by the 1st of July (Full year / Spring Semester).
- 4. This institutional agreement can be terminated or chanced, if communicated at least one academic year beforehand. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
