#### PL TORUNO1:

Partner institutions should send their nominations by email (pls. give student's first and family name, email, area of studies and semester of Erasmus scholarship). The online application should be submitted by the students by the  $\mathbf{1}^{st}$  of November.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 5 weeks after deadlines.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The involved institutions may agree on the procedure of modifying or terminating the bilateral agreement. In case of unilateral modification or termination, a written notice of at least one academic year ahead will be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

## PL TORUNO1:

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain *zal.* or *zaliczenie* (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
