D. Additional requirements

SK BANSKA 01:

- The candidates with disabilities can only be accepted after the consultation with Faculty of Education Matej Bel University in Banska Bystrica.
- The sending institution on the nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) must notify the International Relations Office/ ERASMUS administrator about their interest in studying at the Faculty of Education Matej Bel University Banska Bystrica one month prior to the deadline
- Students must arrive at least 7 days before the academic year starts
- Foreign students coming to Banska Bystrica are automatically enrolled in the buddy system (ESN UMB).
- Students must attend courses
 - Bachelor and Master study programmes minimum 20 credits per one semester
 - · PhD. students minimum 10 credits per one semester
- **Teachers** must notify the departmental coordinator about their interest in teaching at the Faculty of Education at Matej Bel University Banska Bystrica two months prior to their arrival.

- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement or changes in the data set above can be amended annually if communicated before November 30th. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

PL TORUNO1:

Partner institutions should send their nominations by email (pls. give student's first and family name, e-mail, area of studies and semester of Erasmus scholarship).

The online application should be submitted by the students by the 1st of June or 1st of November.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.

Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

- Grades: A EXCELLENT outstanding performance with only minor errors
 - B VERY GOOD above the average standard but with some error,
 - C GOOD generally sound work with a number of notable error
 - D SATISFACTORY fair but with significant shortcomings, E - SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria
 - **FX** FAIL some more work required before the credit can be awarded.

The value of local credits corresponds to ECTS credits

PL TORUN01:

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain zal. or zaliczenie (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
