1. Grading systems of the institutions

B LIEGE07

At Ecole Supérieure des Arts Saint-Luc Liège (B LIEGE07) the grading system varies between 0 (lower) and 20 (highest) with the lowest pass mark being 10. All courses are organized in ECTS credits. A final transcript with the local and ECTS grade is provided to the student. The academic unit is the semester. A semester carries 30 credits.
