- Application documents received after application deadlines will not be accepted.
- In case, if the application documents aren't in Turkish or English language, the applicants have to add the authorized translation of these documents.
- Exchange studies for PhD students are organized according to individual plans.
- It is not possible for exchange students to defend their BA/MA/PhD thesis at the host university.
- Incoming international staff members should apply for visits to the departmental coordinators of the respective faculty (<http://abofisi.ksu.edu.tr/IcerikSayfa.aspx?KatId=21&AltKatId=62>) with copy sent to the International Relations department (int-relations@ksu.edu.tr) of the Kahramanmaraş Sütçü İmam University.
- Applicants with special needs will be contacted before the final approval of the acceptance. Final decision depends on extra services/ facilities available.

- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- Termination of the agreement
This Agreement shall be effective for the period 2014-2021. If either institution wishes to terminate the agreement, one year's notice must be given in writing. For example, notice to terminate mobility from 2015/16 must be given by 1 September 2014. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

1. Grading systems of the institutions

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst. Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain *zal.* or *zaliczenie* (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.

2. Visa
