3. Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEL, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

4. Termination of the agreement

The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force for a period of 6 years. In case of the termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

F. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

TR ORDU 01:

The Ordu University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for a semester.

The Turkish grading system in higher education is based on the 4 to 1,5 scale, where 4 is the best mark and 1,5 is the worst.

The equivalents of the Final Grades are determined according to the table given below:


