1. The receiving institutions will send their decisions within 6-8 weeks after deadline.
2. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
3. Termination of the agreement: The institutions decide in mutual agreement on the procedure of modifying or terminating the agreement. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given.



