D. Additional requirements D FLENSBU01

- Selection process: the partner university is kindly requested to ensure that the language proficiency of the outgoing student(s) is a minimum B2.
- Incoming students can participate in an intensive German language course 3 weeks before lectures start (4 credits) and during the semester (4 credits).
- Europa-Universität Flensburg welcomes students and staff with disabilities and offers necessary facilities and support.
- An orientation week is organized for international students each semester during which students receive information about the university in general, administrative issues, student activities. Student hosts support the orientation of incoming students by organizing a series of cultural and leisure activities.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than two

weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

PL TORUN01:

Partner institutions should send their nominations by email (pis. give student's first and family name, email, area of studies and semester of Erasmus scholarship).

The online application should be submitted by the students by the 1st of June or 1st of November. 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.

3. Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The Inter-Institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unliateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

1. Grading systems of the institutions D FLENSBU01

Europa-Universität Flensburg follows the ECTS system. An average course load has 30 credit points per semester. Student performance is normally evaluated with a grade.

PL TORUN01:

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain *zal*. or *zaliczenie* (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
