Staffs are also required to fill in the application form and bring the original signed and stamped copy.
- 4. Incoming teaching staff must be individually accepted by the department that coordinates the bilateral agreement.
- 5. All incoming students must get a health insurance before they apply for visa. The insurance should be valid in Turkey for the duration of their stay.
- 6. Incoming students can apply to the Health Centre at TED University for minor health related issues. Students are treated free of charge.
- 7. Incoming students must attend the orientation week to take place prior to the start of each term.
- 8. Incoming students will be provided lunch for free of charge.
- Students need to register for the regular courses until the end of the add-drop period, which falls

1. Grading system

Grading Scale at the Nicolaus Copernicus University: The following scale is used for all types of evaluations/examinations:

NCU follows the ECTS scheme, which mean that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education field is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst mark.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional sign of +. It means half of point.
