The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.

Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and an relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

Termination of the agreement

The Inter-Institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unliateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

F. Information

L. Grading systems of the institutions

F GRENOBL 51:

As in all European Union countries;
French Universities use the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). ECTS credits are awarded for successfully completed studies: one academic year correspond to 60 ECTS credits, one semester to 30 ECTS credits.

French Universities use a 20 points grading scale; 20/20 is the highest grade and 0/20 is the lowest.

A score of 20/20 is considered perfect and is rarely (almost never) awarded.

The passing grade at UGA is 10/20 UGA credits are not awarded for courses with a grade below 10/20.

PL TORUNO1:

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are dilucated to course units, lectures, practical works, sets, at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point; + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain zal. or zaliczenie (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
