- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by **I CAGLIAR01** no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force for a period of **6 years**. In case of the termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.

#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

**I CAGLIAR01:** Subject units are generally taught for two semesters. Final assessment of the student is based on the result of one or more examinations, which may be oral and/or written. The pass mark for examinations is 18 out of 30. The highest mark for examinations is 30 out of 30. An excellent performance is usually graded above 28.

**ECTS grading scale**: A= 30 e 30 cum laude; B:27/28/29; C: 24/25/26; D = 21/22/23 E: 18/19/20; F: fail ( see: http://www.unica.it/pub/english/index.jsp?is=23&iso=380)

## PL TORUN01:

#### **ECTS Credits:**

The Nicolaus Copernicus University follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical works, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for six months (a term/semester).

The Polish grading system in higher education is based on the 5 to 2 scale, where 5 is the best mark and 2 is the worst.

Moreover, students can also be marked with additional signs of + and -. Each of them equals half a point: + means 0.5 more. Some courses, however, are not evaluated on such a marking scheme and for these a student may simply obtain *zal.* or *zaliczenie* (EN. 'pass') which means that their workload was satisfactory and they have passed the course.
