- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records/Transcript of Works will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **4 weeks** after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement shall become effective from the academic year [2014/15] and shall remain in effect until the academic year [2020/21]. The contracting institution will review the exchange annually in order to maintain a balance in number of students exchanged.

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year must be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20xx will only take effect as of 1 September 20xx+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

Applications/information on nominated students must reach the ACU Erasmus+ Office by May 30th for the fall semester and November 30th for the spring semester.

2. Visa

The sending and receiving institutions will provide assistance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outbound mobile participants, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education.

Please check with the nearest Turkish Embassy/Consulate whether you are required a student visa or not. Incoming exchange students may be required to obtain a student visa for the duration of their academic stay in Turkey. In such a case, after receiving the Acceptance Letter from Acibadem Mehmet Aydinlar University, exchange students should apply directly in person at the local Turkish Embassy or Consulate for a student visa.

RESIDENCE PERMIT

All incoming exchange students must register with the Directorate General of Migration (Immigration Office) within one month of entering Turkey in order to obtain their residence permits. Residence Permit procedures may change from semester to semester but students are advised accordingly as soon as the info is received from the respective Turkish authority.

3. Insurance

HEALTH INSURANCE

Please be aware that Acibadem Mehmet Ali Aydinlar University does not automatically provide incoming students with insurance cover. All incoming exchange students must have a valid health insurance to cover the duration of their academic stay. Students, who do not hold a valid health insurance for the residence permit application as well as personal needs, must purchase their health insurance coverage upon their arrival. International Office will guide students for the insurance process once they arrive. Please be advised that the health insurance of your country will not be valid for residence permit application and for public hospital use. Those, who come for an Erasmus+ Internship, should also have an Accident and Liability Insurance for the duration of stay.

4. Housing

Acibadem Mehmet Ali Aydınlar University has student guest house near the Campus, Atasehir, where rooms are offered in accordance with availability. However, be aware that Atakent Hospital University (on the European side) is very far away from the Campus (on the Asian side). Unfortunately Istanbul has a huge traffic problem, thus, it is strongly recommended that you find a residence close to the hospital as you will be spending all your time at the hospital.
