- 10 excellent (best possible grade)
- 9 very good
- 8 very good
- 7 good
- 6 sufficient (lowest passing grade)
- 5 or less (failing grades)

Completed study requirements are assessed using grades from 1 to 10.

The failing grades range from 1 to 5 and passing grades from 6 to 10.

Seminars are graded on pass/fail basis.
