Erasmus+ Programme Bilateral Inter-Institutional Agreement

Key Action 1

Learning Mobility for Higher Education Students and Staff among EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme ¹

The institutions agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme.
