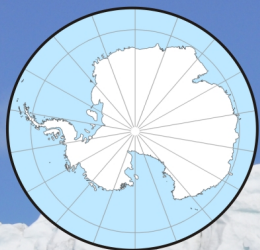


# Polar Climate and Environmental Change in the Last Millennium

- ✎ Causes and effects of climate change in historical times,

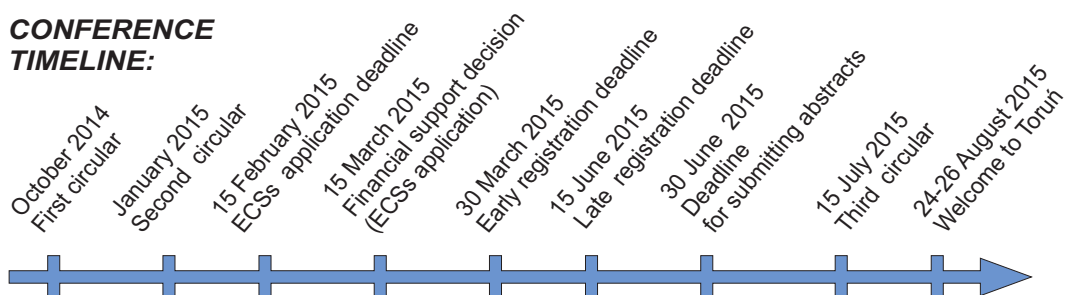
## PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:
