## Rules for the stipend for first-year students of the M.A. degree program in Cognitive Science in English at The Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń:

- 1. A stipend may be sought by first-year students of the M.A. degree program who have been admitted to these studies no later than one year after completing the B.A. degree program.
- 2. The stipend is not awarded to students who already have title of master's degree or equivalent.
- 3. The stipend is paid over the course of one academic year (1.10.2024-30.09.2025).
- 4. The stipend is awarded upon a student's application.

- 6. The application should be submitted by e-mail to the Director of the Deportment of Cognitive Science prof. Arkadiusz Gut (<a href="mailto:arkadiusz.gut@umk.pl">arkadiusz.gut@umk.pl</a>), with a CC sent to the course coordinator prof. Anita Pacholik=Żuromska (<a href="mailto:apz@umk.pl">apz@umk.pl</a>). The deadline for the submission is October 21.
- 7. The stipend is awarded by the committee appointed by the Director of the Department of Cognitive Science.
- 8. The committee evaluates the applications, ranks them, and produces a list of students awarded the stipend. The recipients are informed about the decision by mail.
- 9. The scholarship is awarded to the students who achieved the highest scores in the enrolment process (candidate ranking). The exact number of recipients is determined by the committee.
- 10. A recipient who is granted a dean's leave or is removed from the register of students is no longer eligible to receive the stipend.
